Confidentiality and Use of Data

In line with EU GDPR law, all application data has been treated as confidential throughout the judging and shortlisting process by everyone involved.

Conflict of Interest

All applications are anonymised for the judging process and judges take conflict of interest very seriously to ensure the integrity of the process, including signing relevant agreements. If judges recognise an applicant, they are required to state any conflict of interest immediately. Any judge disclosing a conflict of interest is excluded from assessing the specific application and scores are provided by other members of the judging panel only.
