



Berfin Deniz

Composer and music teacher Berfin Deniz, who sees music as an intercultural bridge, completed her music teaching education at Ankara Music and Fine Arts University. She is currently continuing her education in the composition department at Ankara Music and Fine Arts University. Her compositions have been performed at various music festivals from Turkey to France.



Burçe Karaca
